EDUC 7250 Inclusive Education

2nd Semester 2018-2019

This course introduces students to the study of inclusion of students with special needs and explores the development and the role of inclusive education, and aims to enhance the understanding of the individual requirements of students with diverse needs. The course pays special attention to students with disabilities in mainstream schools, and the strategies that can be used to optimise their educational experiences.

Teaching Without Discrimination

Students from HKBU will collaborate with Two Nominees Limited to offer training to kindergarten teachers who provide mental health early intervention to their pupils. One of the skills and strategies will be the use of two novel methods, namely "Heart Cards" and "Japan Pastel Nagomi Art" to release the emotional stress of students with SEN (special education needs). Through this service-learning component, students take active role in further promoting an inclusive community.
