### Food waste in Hong Kong

- Food waste accounted for 31% of municipal solid waste (2018)
- Each day produce 3565t of leftovers
- Main sources: domestic food waste
- Commercial and industrial food waste are also one of the sources

For food Quality check .It have Three step


- 1.Wholesaler would send some sample
- 2. Then check the sample
- It have database (600-700 sample) to check the sample . Those are their experience
- 3. Staff check the sample (double check quality)
- Staff have training for the food quality
- Every week for double checking (judgment sampling) taste (like nuts)
- (Nonprobability Sampling : The investigator selects the units deliberately.)

#### Cap. 132 Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance

#### Part V – Food and Drugs

Current food legislation Any person who sale any unfit food for human consumption is an offence under Section 54 of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) The offender is liable to a maximum fine of \$50,000 and 6 months imprisonment















#### Bread Programme - FoodLink

**\$8** in Hong Kong can buy one bread. Someone think that it is a cheapest things for satisfying the hunger. However, the corner of hong kong have some of the people who cannot spend their money to buy this "cheapest food".

- In Hong Kong, there are nearly 1.4 million of people classified as the poor.
- Although we lived in the wealthy city, there are many people below the poverty line.
- However, about 3,600 tonnes of food waste were sent to landfill in Hong Kong.
- So, we need to collect leftover bread to help them and reduce the food waste in Hong Kong
