- A highly toxic chemical is defined by the U.S. Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA) as a chemical that falls in any of these three categories:
- 1.LD50(Lethal Dose causing 50% death of test animals) of or less than 50mg/kg when administered orally.

<sup>2.</sup>LD50 of or less than 200mg/kg when administered by continuous skin contact for 24 hours.

<sup>3.</sup>LC50 in air of or less than of 200ppm or 2mg/L when administered by continuous inhalation for one hour.
