HONG KONG BAPTIST UNIVERSITY

Regulations on Posting of Materials on Campus

1. Preamble

While the University upholds the rights to freedom of expression, equal opportunities and inclusiveness, the exercise of these rights should not violate the laws or infringe the rights of others. This set of regulation ("Regulations") applies to posting of all materials that are visible to the University community on all premises under the management of the University. In addition, the University endeavours to assist students and staff to promote activities and events organised by the University's academic units and/or student organisations ("Events"). As such, the University has designated Information Display Spaces on campus for posting of publicity materials to facilitate the effective promotion and to increase the publicity of these Events.

2. Definitions

- 2.1 Materials refer to any banners, posters, notices or printed materials ("Materials"). Publicity materials refer to Materials that promote any Event ("Publicity Materials").
- 2.2 Information Display Spaces refer to display boards, notice stands, foam board stands, noticeboard locations and the designated banner locations. Locations of the noticeboards and designated banners provided on campus are specified in **Appendix 1**.

3. Principles on Posting of Materials

- 3.1 All Materials and their contents shall comply with all laws and regulations of Hong Kong, including but not limited to The Law of the People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, constitutional provisions, ordinances, subsidiary legislation, rules and regulations having the force of law and rules of common law and equity.
- 3.2 All Materials and their contents shall not:
 - (a) without prejudice to the generality of paragraph 3.1, constitute or cause the occurrence of offences against the laws and regulations of Hong Kong, including but not limited to offences endangering national security, or be otherwise contrary to the interest of national security;

- (b) contain any content that is abusive, discriminatory, defamatory, immoral, obscene, scandalous or that may cause embarrassment to the University or bring the University into disrepute;
- (c) cause any damage to the property of the University;
- (d) contravene any health and safety regulations of the University;
- (e) cause any inconvenience, obstruction or potential danger to users or passerby of the area; or
- (f) contain any form of promotion or advertisement of any business entity.

Typical examples of locations that are not suitable for posting are set out in **Appendix 2**.

3.3 A Rapid Response Team ("RRT") consisting of the University's senior management, Student Affairs Office, Faculty Members and administration office heads is set up to review problematic posting as and when necessary. Any posting that is considered by the RRT that violates the Regulations will be removed immediately.

4. Specific Regulations for Publicity Materials

- 4.1 For events promotions, electronic means is encouraged to reduce carbon footprint. Reduction, reuse and recycling of Publicity Materials should be accorded the top priority to promotion.
- 4.2 When posting in paper form is required, Publicity Materials should only be posted on the Information Display Spaces. They should not be posted on any other places without the prior approval of the University.
- 4.3 The official name of the respective academic or administrative unit or student organisation should be printed or stamped on all Publicity Materials.
- 4.4 The period of posting is 14 days or up to the date of the activity or event referred to in the Publicity Materials, whichever is shorter. The end date of posting should be marked clearly on the Publicity Materials. The Publicity Materials should be removed immediately upon the end of the period of posting by the person(s) who posted them up.
- 4.5 The size of Publicity Materials should not exceed the area of the allocated notice

display space(s).

- 4.6 Academic or administrative unit or student organisation which authorises the posting up of the Publicity Materials should ensure proper compliance with the Regulations and be responsible for any breach thereof.
- 4.7 Temporary directional signs may be posted on places other than the Information Display Spaces on the date of the activity or event subject to prior approval of the University.
- 4.8 Any Publicity Materials which are in breach of the Regulations will be removed without prior notice.
- 4.9 Any Material that promotes any event organised by an organisation not being part of the University community, except the Government of Hong Kong or a statutory body of Hong Kong, is prohibited without prior approval of the University.
- 4.10 Academic and administrative units may issue guidelines on Publicity Materials to be posted up or distributed within the areas managed by them, including entrance and exterior walls of such areas. Such guidelines shall not be inconsistent with the provisions of the Regulations.

5. Breach of Regulations and/or Guidelines

- 5.1 The Director of Estates or his/her delegate shall implement the Regulations and/or the guidelines and shall bear primary responsibility to take immediate actions in respect of any breach of the Regulations and/or the guidelines or any unauthorised posting and/or distribution of Materials in all common areas of the University.
- 5.2 The Heads/Directors of departments/offices/units or their delegates shall implement the Regulations and/or the guidelines and shall bear primary responsibility to take immediate actions in respect of any breach of the Regulations and/or the guidelines or any unauthorised posting and/or distribution of materials within the areas managed by them in their respective departments/offices/units.
- 5.3 The Directors of respective managing agents or their delegates shall implement the Regulations and/or the guidelines in their managed areas of University-wide teaching, learning, research and amenity spaces and shall bear primary responsibility to take immediate action in respect of any breach of the Regulations and/or the guidelines or any unauthorised posting and/or distribution of Materials within the areas managed by them. Please refer to **Appendix 3** for a full list of

venues and the managing agents.

- 5.4 The Heads/Directors of departments/offices/units or their delegates shall take necessary follow-up actions on the staff member(s) of the respective departments/offices/units involved in any case of posting or distributing unauthorised Materials on campus or breach of the Regulations and/or the guidelines.
- 5.5 The Director of Student Affairs, the Director of College of International Education, the School of Continuing Education or his/her delegate shall take necessary follow-up actions on the student organisation(s) and/or the student(s) involved in any case of posting or distributing unauthorised Materials on campus or breach of the Regulations and/or the guidelines.
- 5.6 The Director of Estates or his/her delegate shall take necessary follow-up actions in respect of all matters relating to the posting and/or distribution of Materials by anyone other than those mentioned in paragraphs 5.4 and 5.5 above.
- 5.7 Depending on the circumstances, any posting and distribution of unauthorised Materials should be reported to supervising Dean or Vice-President as appropriate.

6. Delegation of authority by the University Administration

- 6.1 The RRT shall make a final decision of determining if any particular posting is in breach of the Regulations.
- 6.2 The Vice-President (Administration) and Secretary has the overall responsibility in respect of the implementation and administration of the Regulations.
- 6.3 The Estates Office is authorised to publish the Regulations and act in accordance with the provisions in the Regulations.

7. Review

7.1 The Regulations may be reviewed by the Risk Management Committee annually or as and when required.
