Project Timeline and Current Progress

- The project started in September 2016 and is scheduled to complete by end-2018.
- Phase 1 on the core financial and procurement modules, and academic Timesheet System will go live by Jan 2018. Phase 2 on the Accounts Receivable module will go live by end-2018.
